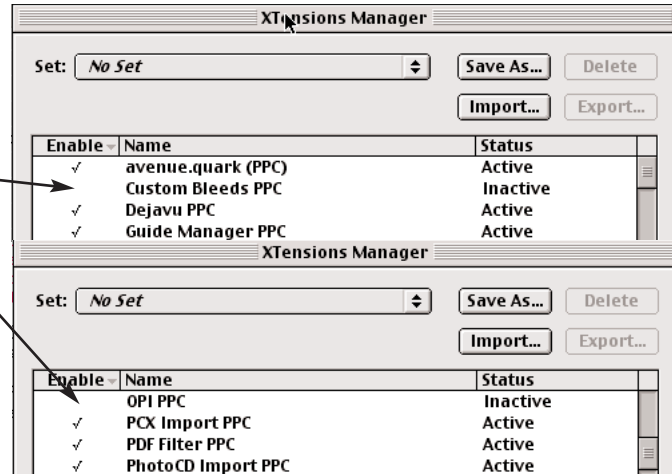
Before following the print settings you must disable two XTensions, which are:

→ **Custom Bleeds PPC
&
OPI PPC**

In the Menu Bar select Utilities, then select XTensions Manager.

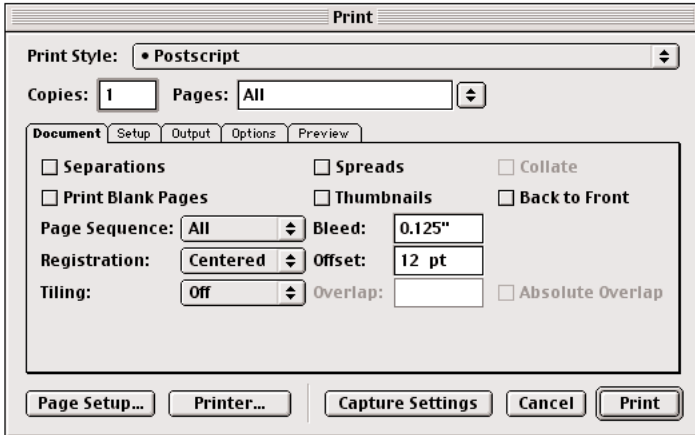
Disable these two XTensions by deselecting the check mark

NOTE: You must quit quark and relaunch before changes take effect.

Document Tab

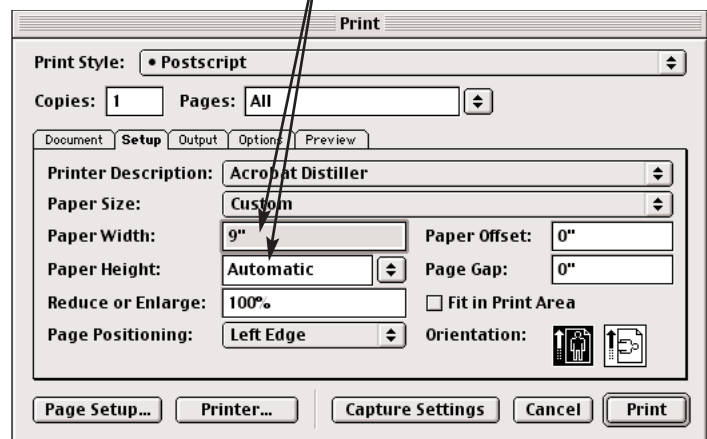

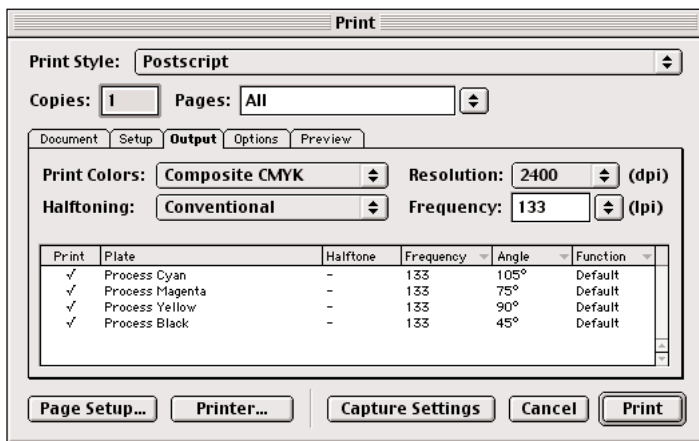

Add 1" to your document's width and leave your height to Automatic

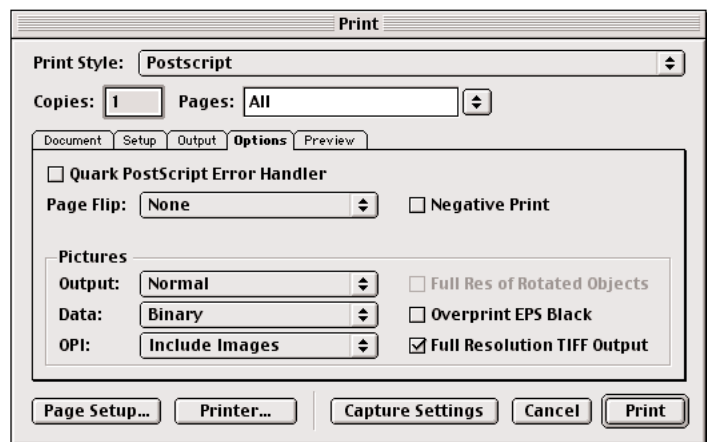

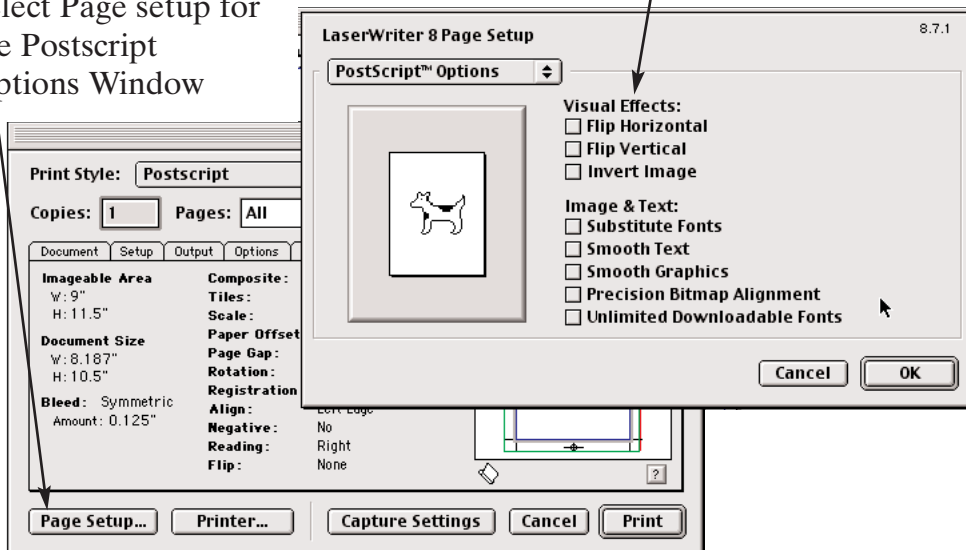


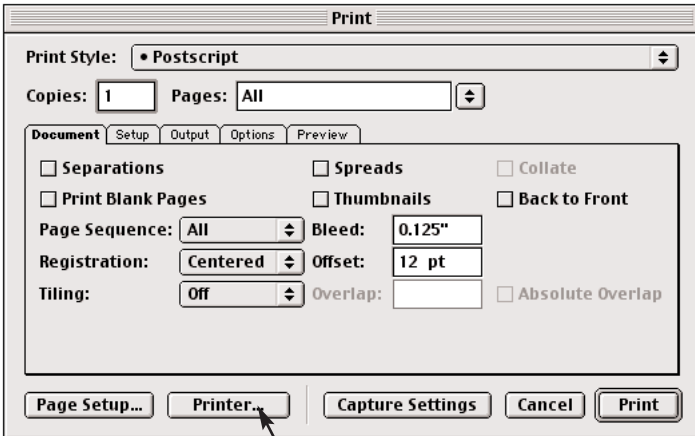

Select Page setup for the Postscript Options Window

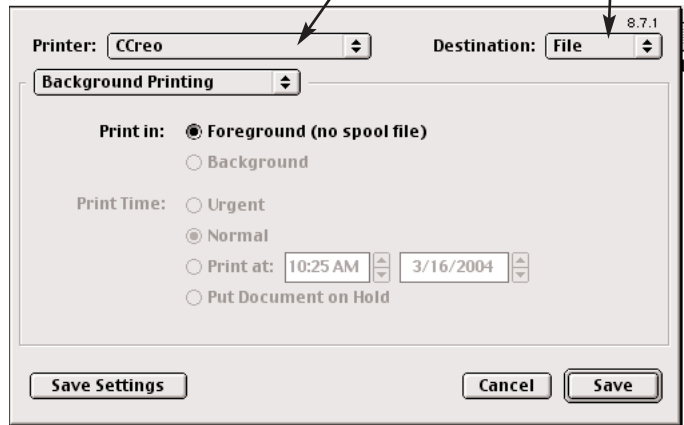

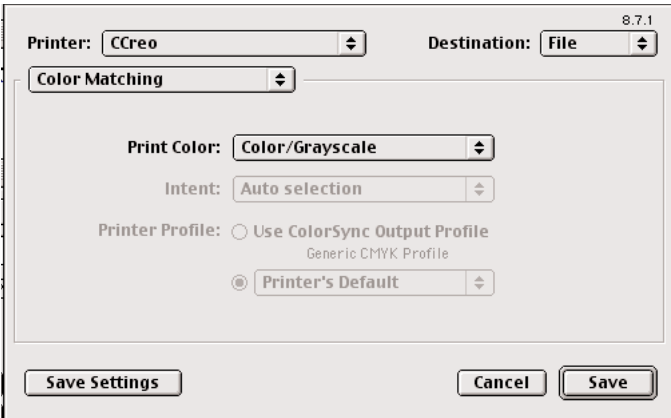


After all settings are entered, click on "Printer..."

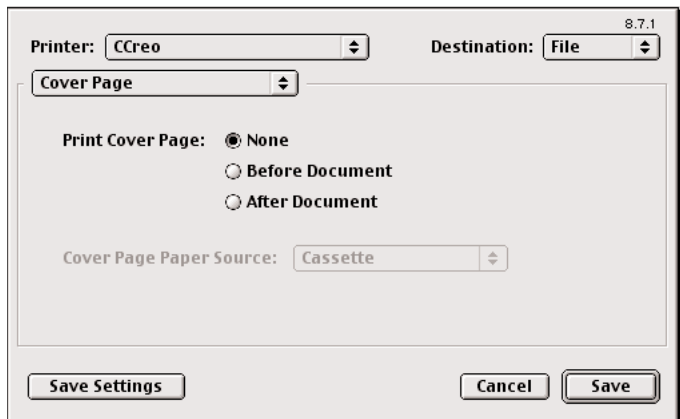
Select any postscript printer from the list

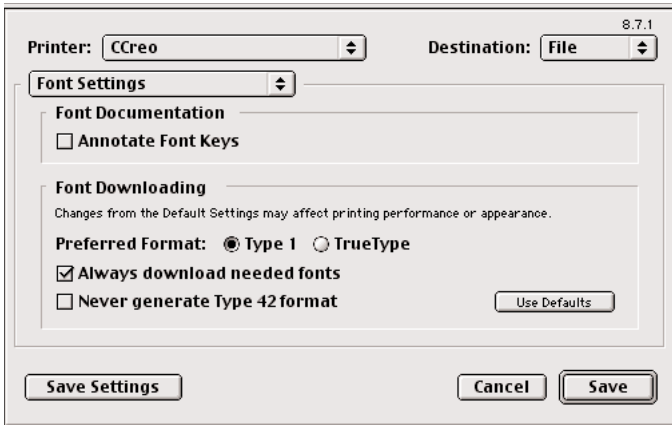

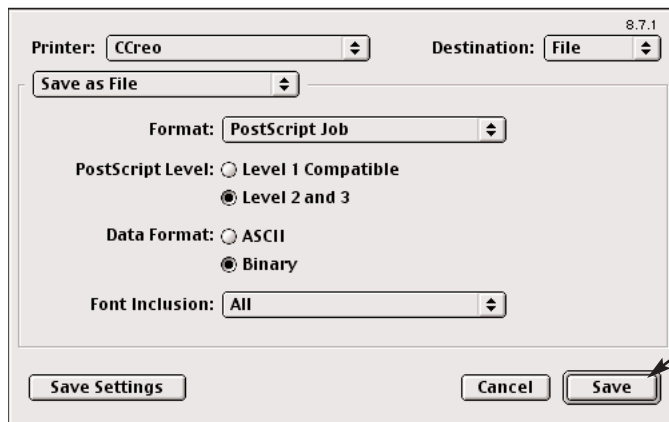
